Religion's decline in the modern world turns out to be a myth.

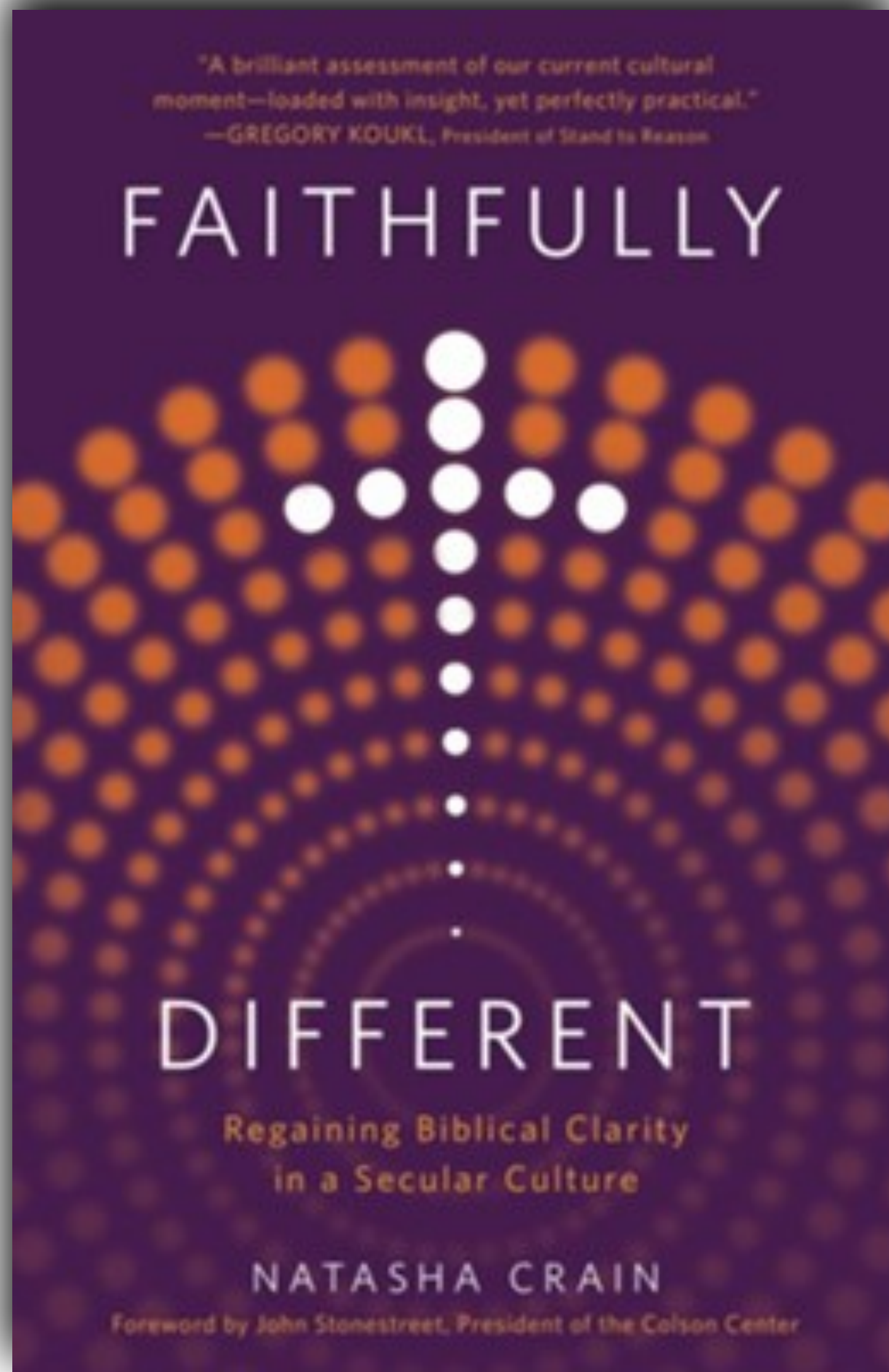
