Who are we looking for?

- 1) Mature disciples who have experience in the following areas:
 - 1) Small group leadership
 - 2) Studying the Bible with "seekers"
 - 3) Mentoring young Christians
- 2) Men & Women who are well suited to campus ministry, including recent college graduates.
- 3) Applicants within one year of graduating may be consideredbut they would need to be enrolled at the University of Florida, Santa Fe College or online school so they could live in Gainesville.
- 4) Men and Women willing to go anywhere and do anything for the sake of the gospel.

The Training

- We believe that the most effective way to train young ministers is to walk with them. In the spirit of Jesus' method with his disciples, we are committed to a training regimen that at its core is all about spending maximum time with our interns.

- Formal training includes a curriculum of weekly intern meetings focused on the most vital aspects of ministry. Each month we focus on a different theme such as a minister's prayer life, faith & vision, prioritizing and scheduling, studying with the lost, raising up leaders and more.

- Monthly book assignments in coordination with the theme will be given to help the interns absorb the material.

-Two eight-week classes a year we call 'Cross-Training' focus on topics such as leadership development, reaching the lost, building a culture and more. Additionally, interns will meet regularly with our congregational teacher for further bible training.

Application Process

The following must be included in your application:

- 1) Resume- *include ministry training* & *experience along with experience outside of church*
- 2) Complete M.I.T. Employment Application (*Separate document you will find on our website under the "M.I.T." tab*)
- 3) College G.P.A. (Include current G.P.A. if not yet graduated)
- 4) Letter of recommendation from current church leader (*Will also accept letters of rec. from any other ministry leaders you have spent significant time with.*)

5) Include a statement answering the following questions:

Why are you interested in this program?

What are your expectations for this internship?

Include in your statement your availability- when you can begin

Interviews

Once the application(s) have been reviewed the Gainesville staff will conduct interviews with chosen applicants

- Chosen applicants will be invited to visit Gainesville (if from out of town) to connect with the staff, meet the church and interact with the campus ministry.
- For those unable to attend in person we will conduct interviews with video conferencing.
- The date of applicant's visit will be decided based on availability

Start Date

If possible, we prefer interns to begin in June or July to allow for a couple months before the start of the Fall semester- but we are willing to be flexible as we understand there can be circumstances that do not allow that date to work.
